Religious Funds Pressure Firms on Policies

When Kimberly Clark, which makes Huggies diapers and Kleenex tissue, began matching employee contributions in Planned Parenthood, the Ave Maria Mutual Funds, which manages its money according to Catholic principles, promptly sold 30,000 shares.

Huggies matches employees' contributions to Planned Parenthood. Kirkland diapers are also manufactured by Kimberly-Clark.

Pampers expanded medical coverage for employees to include traveling for abortions after Roe v. Wade was overturned.
